## OUR SAFEGUARDING GOAL

## KIDS SHOULD NEVER BE HURT

Sadly, some people do hurt kids by hitting them, touching them inappropriately, yelling at them, or not taking care of them.

## BSL'S JOB

BSL tries to stop anyone from hurting kids. If someone hurts you during a BSL activity, or if you see someone hurting another kid, please tell a BSL worker. They are here to listen and help.

## IT'S NOT YOUR FAULT

If someone hurts you or you see someone else being hurt, tell a BSL worker. They will listen to you, help you, and make sure you and other kids are safe.
