

BSL Community Support Program — Case assessment process and fee structure

Step 1: Expression of Interest (EOI)

- Online lodgment of EOI
- Assessment of EOI conducted by BSL
- BSL will inform you of the outcome of your EOI

EOI Fees: \$300 per case (nonrefundable) Step 2: Prelodgment stage

- Conduct initial meeting and intensive case assessment
- Assess Australian
 Supporter's financial
 and settlement
 capacity
- Applicant's
 Employment and
 Education service
 planning
- Case appraisal and formal registration into CSP

BSL Fees: \$3430

(nonrefundable)

Step 3: Visa application lodgment

- Final Case preparation
- Visa Application finalised and lodged
- Visa application processed by Department of Home Affairs, interview by Embassy, medical, police check, and security clearances

Fees:

BSL: \$6050

1st Visa application Charge (VAC) of Department of Home Affairs: \$2955

(nonrefundable)

Step 4: Visa granted

Australian supporter assessed by Department of Social Services (DSS) for their capacity to provide Assurance of Support (AOS) – based on income test

Visa granted and flight bookings made by Australian supporter

Pre-arrival arrangements between BSL and Australian Supporter

Fees:

BSL: \$3130

2nd Visa application Charge (VAC) of Department of Home Affairs: \$16,444 for primary applicant, \$2680 for each secondary applicant Step 5: Arrival to Australia and Settlement

- Assurance of Support actioned for 12 months
- 12 month Case management plan and settlement support
- Implementation of the integration plan (employment, education and settlement plan)

Fees:

BSL Refundable bond \$5,000

HSP Mandatory HSP Services Fees: To Be Confirmed by relevant HSP Provider

BSL Employment and settlement support: \$1000
